UAPB/AM&N Homecoming Parade Policy and Guidelines

POLICY

- The UAPB Homecoming Parade is one of a series of annual events where the University joins all its constituencies in acknowledgement and celebration of its mission and service to mankind.
- **Campaign materials** may not be displayed on the elected official's vehicle. Only incumbent national, state, county and city elected officials participate in the parade. Identification of elected officials shall be limited to name and office held.
- For safety reasons, no one will be allowed to ride on the hood of a car or truck. Also, throwing treats or any objects to spectators along the parade route is forbidden.

PARADE GUIDELINES/DIRECTIONS

- All dignitaries should line-up on Martin St. East of Main Street (between Main and State streets) Participant line-up will commence at 8:00 a.m.
- **BANDS:** UAPB's Band will go to the MAIN St. and Line-up facing NORTH WITH THE LINE FILLING TO THE SOUTH All other bands are to unload on 9th & Walnut, then WALK South on Olive/Walnut turn East on Martin and proceed to Main St. –South of Pine & Martin Streets. Once unloaded the bus should make a right/left onto Laurel Street which circles the Pine Bluff High School Football Field and proceed back to 8th Street. Make a left onto 8th Street and proceed to Cherry St. Make a right onto Cherry St. and Make a right onto 2nd Street and make a left onto Chestnut proceed North to make left onto Barraque Street which is the end of the Parade.
- **FIRST ALL PARTICIPANTS PLEASE GO TO PINE BLUFF HIGH SCHOOL'S NORTH PARKING LOT BETWEEN 9TH AND 11TH ON WALNUT St. UNDER THE UAPB BLACK /GOLD TENT FOR FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS AND PARADE INDENIFICATION NUMBER AT 8:00 A.M. SATURDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2016. PLEASE FEEL FREE TO WALK TO PARADE INDENTIFICATION NUMBER STATION. ONLY PARADE ENTRIES ARE ALLOWED IN THE PARKING LOT – ALL OTHER VEHICLES MUST PARK ELSEWHERE. PARADE LINE-UP WILL COMMENCE AT 8:20 A.M. LATE ARRIVALS WILL BE PLACED AT THE END OF THE PARADE OR EXCLUDED FROM THE PARADE.**
 - *Place your parade identification number in the lower left (Driver side) of the front windshield. The official title entry listed on the form may be used only in the parade no exceptions Floats and 18-Wheelers in the parade should proceed to Walnut Street headed south.*
 - *Individuals dropping parade participants off and leaving should have prior knowledge of the location of their respective float, car and should know the registered name of their organization. The drivers should drop-off at LAUREL St which circles the Pine Bluff High School's Football Field and proceed back to 8th Street. ALL FLOATS, CARS, TRUCKS AND OTHER MOTORED VEHICLES PARTICIPATING IN THE PARADE SHOULD PROCEED TO PARKING LOT AND PROCEED TO LINE-UP HEADED SOUTH ON WALNUT STREET and HEADED EAST ON MARTIN ST.*

ATTENTION: NEW PARADE ROUTE FOR 2018

PARADE STARTS AT MARTIN/ MAIN STREET. Turn LEFT on MAIN STREET and travel NORTH TO BARRAQUE STREET. Turn LEFT on BARRAQUE STREET for one block. PARADE ENDS. Units traveling back to UAPB's campus (by bus)continue on BARRAQUE STREET until CHERRY STREET. Turn RIGHT onto CHERRY and travel to PULLEN. Turn LEFT onto PULLEN and travel to UNIVERSITY DRIVE OR TRAVEL TO L.A. 'PREXY' DAVIS DR. TURN RIGHT on UNIVERSITY DRIVE OR L.A. 'PREXY' DAVIS DR to UAPB's campus.
